Reisig wins 700 games with Trinity teams

Ray Reisig, 7th grade teacher and basketball coach reached a career record of 700 basketball wins in December of 2005.

Reisig has a coaching career that spans 3 decades of developing young players into athletes. Under his leadership Trinity won the championship at the National Lutheran School Tournament in Valparaiso, Indiana in 2001. He also led the Tigers to numerous championships in league play and at the annual L.E.S.T. competitions against teams from all over the Northwest, California, Hawaii and Alaska.

While 700 wins is a challenging accomplishment in any career, it is made even more impressive in that they have all been with our program, TLS.

Every athlete has had a coach that taught them the game, shown them how to be the best they can be and then expected it. Reisig did that for hundreds of Trinity School basketball players, and gave them the opportunity to compete and win. In addition, he cares about the young men who played for him. It is evident in their response to him and to their teammates.

Students and staff celebrated the 700th win with Mr. Reisig in a surprise assembly. He was presented with a plaque from the school. His assistant coaches and Trinity alumni, Brandon Bishop and Brian Fulcher presented him with two framed Trinity jerseys, each bearing the number 700.
